Duties for the positions being elected are

President

Preside at regular and special meetings
Represent the Chapter at meetings where official representation of the Chapter is desirable
Be a member of the Area Operating Committee representing the Chapter
Provide leadership for programs and activities for the Chapter during the term of office
Appoint such committees as are necessary to implement the objectives of the Chapter
Submit an Annual Report of Chapter activities to the Area Director and the Society
Submit the names of Chapter officers and Delegate(s) elected for the ensuing year annually

Vice President

Succeed to the office of the President and carry out its duties if the President is unable to serve
Assume responsibilities for the work of Committees as assigned by the President

Secretary

Maintain Chapter records
Record and distributes minutes of Chapter meetings and Chapter Executive Committee meetings
Notify Chapter members of meetings
Assume the duties of the Treasurer as necessary

Treasurer

Maintain all financial records of the Chapter
Supervise the receipt and disbursement of funds as directed by the Chapter Executive Committee
Maintain Chapter funds in a depository approved by the Chapter Executive Committee
Transmit to Society Headquarters the audited income & expense statement for the fiscal year and submit to the IRS any required tax documents.
Assume the duties of the Secretary as necessary

Delegate to the Society House of Delegates

Operate in accordance with House of Delegates Operating Procedures and Society Bylaws.
Keep the Chapter informed of House of Delegates actions and proposed actions.
Act on House of Delegates mail ballots on behalf of the Chapter
